

# PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION, WEST BENGAL

Applications in the prescribed format given below are invited from Indian Citizens and such other nationals as are declared eligible by Govt. of India for recruitment to the undermentioned posts. The number of vacancies may increase.

**N.B.: ABILITY TO READ, WRITE AND SPEAK IN BENGALI IS AN ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION FOR RECRUITMENT TO ALL POSTS AND SERVICES MENTIONED BELOW. PROVIDED THAT THE SAID COMPULSORY REQUIREMENT OF KNOWLEDGE IN BENGALI IS NOT APPLICABLE FOR NEPALI SPEAKING CANDIDATES FROM THE HILL AREAS OF THE DISTRICT OF DARJEELING. THIS WILL BE TESTED AT THE TIME OF INTERVIEW.**

1. **PROFESSOR OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY FOR GOVT. ENGG. AND TECHNOLOGICAL COLLEGES IN W.B.G.S.: Eight** (4 reserved for S.C. candidates)

**PAY:** Rs. 16,400/- - 22,400/-.

**QUALIFICATIONS : Essential:** i) Doctorate degree with a first class degree at Bachelor's or Master's Level in the appropriate branch of Engg./Technology; ii) 10(ten) years' experience in Teaching/Research/Industry out of which 5 years' must be at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent.

**NOTE:** Candidates from Industry/Profession with Master's degree in Engg./Technology and with professional work which is significant and with 10 years experience of which at least 5 years' should be at a senior level would also be eligible.

**AGE:** Not more than 50 years on 01.01.2009, upper age limit is relaxable in the case of candidates who are specially qualified and experienced and also in case of candidates who are already employed in Institutions/organisations under the State Govt. or Central Govt.

3. **INSPECTOR OF FACTORIES IN WEST BENGAL FACTORIES SERVICE: Eleven** (4 reserved for S.C. and 1 each for S.T. & B.C. candidates).

**QUALIFICATIONS : Essential:** i) Degree in Mechanical or Civil or Electrical Engg. or any other qualifications in Mechanical or Civil or Electrical Engg., exempting a candidate from appearing in sections A and B of the Associate Membership Examination of the Institution of Engineers (India), preference being given to those having qualifications in Mechanical Engineering; ii) Adequate engineering experience in a Workshop or a manufacturing concern of repute.

**AGE:** Not more than 35 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable for specially qualified and experienced candidates.

4. **WELFARE-CUM-ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER & EX-OFFICIO DEPUTY MILK COMMISSIONER IN THE WEST BENGAL HIGHER DAIRY DEVELOPMENT SERVICE (GENERAL): One**

**PAY:** Rs. 10,000/- - 15,525/-.

**QUALIFICATIONS : Essential:** i) Second class Honours or Master's degree in Arts, Science or Commerce; ii) Eight years' experience in a responsible capacity in dealing with the Administrative Work and the work relating to Welfare of the staff or workers in any Govt. organization, or a statutory body or a Commercial Concern of repute.

**DESIRABLE:** A diploma in Labour and Social Welfare.

**NOTE:** Qualifications are relaxable at the Commission's discretion for otherwise well qualified and experienced candidates.

**AGE:** Not more than 40 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable for the highly qualified and experienced candidates and for persons already in the service of a Govt. or a statutory body or a recognised institution.

5. **DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF SCHOOL EDUCATION (INTEGRATED EDUCATION FOR DISABLED CHILDREN) UNDER THE SCHOOL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, WEST BENGAL: One**

**PAY:** Rs. 10,000/- - 15,525/-.

**QUALIFICATIONS : Essential:** i) Master Degree in any discipline; ii) R.C.I. approved Degree/Diploma in Special Education of Deaf/Blind/Physically or Mentally Handicapped or equivalent; iii) Five years' Teaching/Administrative experience to impart education to Deaf/Blind/Mentally Retarded in a recognised institution and/or combined five years' experience in these fields; iv) The candidates must have registration as rehabilitation Professional under the Rehabilitation Council of India Act, 1992 (34 of 1992).

**DESIRABLE:** i) M.Ed. in Special Education; ii) Knowledge of Computer Operation.

**AGE:** Not more than 45 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable at the Commission's discretion for candidates having higher qualifications and or longer experience than those prescribed.

6. **DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF FISHERIES (MICROBIOLOGY AND PARASITOLOGY) IN THE WEST BENGAL FISHERIES SERVICE: One**

**NOTE:** Qualifications and experience are relaxable for candidates having longer experience or higher qualifications in the relevant field than those prescribed.

**AGE:** Not more than 40 years on 01.01.2009 relaxable upto 45 years for (a) specially qualified and/or experienced candidates and (b) for persons holding substantive appointment under the Govt.

7. **ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF FISHERIES IN WEST BENGAL FISHERIES SERVICE (GENERAL BRANCH): Eleven** (2 reserved for S.C. and 1 each reserved for S.T. & B.C. candidates)

**QUALIFICATIONS : Essential:** i) Second class Master's Degree in Zoology or Chemistry or Bio-Chemistry or Applied Chemistry or Second Class Honours Degree in Zoology or Chemistry or a degree in Fishery Technology or its equivalent; ii) Two years' experience in Fishery practices (Production & Marketing) of West Bengal or two years' experience in Research in any recognised Institution on problems concerning fisheries or fish technology relaxable at the Commission's discretion in suitable cases.

**QUALIFICATIONS : Essential:** i) Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering or its equivalent or A Masters' Degree in Agriculture or Geology or Geography or Soil Science or a Masters' Degree in Remote Sensing and Geographical Information System or its equivalent; ii) The candidate must secure 55% marks in Graduation/Masters' Degree; iii) Experience in Computer Software or Remote Sensing or Geographical Information System for two years in any Government Department or Statutory Body or Government undertaking or in academic institution or in industry.

**DESIRABLE:** A doctorate degree in Science or Applied Science or M.E. or M.Tech degree.

**AGE:** Not more than 35 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable for candidates having higher qualifications or longer experience than those prescribed or for candidates holding substantive appointment under the Govt. of West Bengal or Govt. of India.

11. **POSTS IN WEST BENGAL AGRICULTURAL SERVICE (ADMINISTRATIVE): Sixty** (30 reserved for S.C., 9 for S.T., 6 for B.C. and 1 for Persons with Disabilities, suffering from Blindness or Low Vision).

**QUALIFICATIONS : Essential:** i) Bachelor Degree in Agriculture with four years degree course.

**DESIRABLE:** i) Knowledge of Agricultural conditions in West Bengal.

**AGE:** Not more than 35 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable for departmental candidates as well as for well-qualified and experienced candidates.

12. **ASSISTANT ENGINEER (ELECTRICAL) IN WEST BENGAL SERVICE OF ENGINEERS (ELECTRICAL) UNDER PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, GOVT. OF WEST BENGAL: Fourteen** (4 each reserved for S.C. and S.T. and 1 for B.C. candidates).

**PAY:** Rs. 8,000/- - 13,500/-.

**QUALIFICATIONS : Essential:** Degree in Electrical Engineering or equivalent.

**DESIRABLE:** One year's Post-graduate practical training/study/research/practical engineering experience.

**AGE:** Not more than 32 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable for those who have been in the employ of the Central or State Government or any statutory body recognised for the purpose by Government and who are not out of such employment for more than a year on 01.01.2009 upto the extent of actual period spent continuously in such employment.

**NOTE:** i) Candidates will be selected on the basis of a competitive examination followed by interview; ii) Eligible candidates would be called in for the written examination. Thereafter candidates qualifying in the written examination would be called to interview; iii) The syllabus for the written examination will generally be in conformity with the educational standard/technical qualifications as prescribed in the essential qualification. Details of the syllabus and date, time and venue of the written examination will be intimated to eligible candidates in due course; iv) The Commission reserves the right for fixing qualifying marks both for the written examination and the interview and also in aggregate in respect of General, S.C., S.T. and B.C. candidates; v) No candidate will be allowed to take more than three chances.

**FEE :** Candidates must enclose with their application a fee of Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred) only for all the posts by Indian Postal Order which **MUST BE PURCHASED ON A DATE AFTER PUBLICATION OF THIS ADVERTISEMENT** and crossed and endorsed to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, West Bengal, or by a receipted Challan from a Govt. Treasury in West Bengal or the Reserve Bank of India, Kolkata under the head "0051-00-105-State PSC Examination fees-001-Examination fees-16 other fees". The Postal Orders should be made payable at G.P.O., Kolkata. Money Order, Cheque, Bank Draft, Cash etc. will not be accepted. No application will be considered unless accompanied with the requisite application fees. Candidates belonging to S.C./ S.T. of West Bengal and persons with disabilities specified under Persons With Disabilities Rules, 1999 are not required to pay any fee. The application of such candidates will not be accepted if the same is not accompanied with the attested copy of S.C./S.T./Persons with Disabilities certificate. Such exemption of fees is, however, not applicable to any B.C. candidate. No claim for refund of the fee will be entertained nor will it be held in reserve for any other examination.

## INFORMATION

1. Candidates who wish to apply for more than one category of posts should submit separate application alongwith requisite fees for each.
2. The qualifications prescribed in the advertisement are as per the notified recruitment rules issued by Government.
3. All the degrees/diplomas/certificates mentioned in the advertisement must have been obtained from recognised Universities/Institutions.

4. The prescribed 'essential qualifications' are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle applicants to be called in for the interview. Where the number of applications received in response to the advertisement is large and it is not convenient or possible for the Commission to interview all the applicants the Commission may restrict the number of candidates for interview to a reasonable limit on the basis of either qualifications or experience higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement or on the basis of a Screening Test /Written Test .
5. In cases where no Division/Class is awarded and only grading is done, exact percentage of marks and conversion formula adopted are to be mentioned with documentary evidence.
6. Where experience of a number of years is prescribed as an item of qualification this would mean only experience/research experience gained in full time employment/research.  
[ Certificate(s) from the Head(s) of Organisation(s)/Department(s) for the entire experience claimed, clearly mentioning the duration of employment (date, month and year) and indicating basic pay and consolidated pay must be furnished together with applications. The certificate(s) should also mention the nature of duties performed/experience obtained in the post(s) with duration(s)].
7. Besides pay, the posts carry allowances as admissible.
8. The benefits of reservation of vacancies and upper age concession upto 5 years are admissible only to S.C. and S.T. candidates of West Bengal and upto 3 years to B.C.candidates of West Bengal. S.C., S.T. and B.C. candidates of other States may apply for unreserved vacancies as general candidates. Such benefits are also available upto 45 years for Persons with Disabilities.
