Applications in the prescribed format given below are invited from Indian Citizens and such other nationals as are declared eligible by Govt. of India for recruitment to the undermentioned posts. The number of vacancies may increase. Post at (4) is permanent and Post at (5) are temporary. All other posts are temporary (likely to be permanent).

N.B.: ABILITY TO READ, WRITE AND SPEAK IN BENGALI IS AN ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION FOR RECRUITMENT TO ALL POSTS AND SERVICES MENTIONED BELOW. PROVIDED THAT THE SAID COMPULSORY REQUIREMENT OF KNOWLEDGE IN BENGALI IS NOT APPLICABLE FOR NEPALI SPEAKING CANDIDATES FROM THE HILL AREAS OF THE DISTRICT OF DARJEELING. THIS WILL BE TESTED AT THE TIME OF INTERVIEW.

- ii) ELECTRONICS & COMMUNICATION ENGINEERING : ONE (reserve for S.T. candidates)
- iii) COMPUTER SCIENCE & ENGINEERING : ELEVEN (2 reserved for S.C., and 1 for B.C. candidates)
- iv) TEXTILE TECHNOLOGY: FIVE (2 reserved for S.C. and 1 each reserved for B.C. candidates and Persons with disabilities)
- v) LEATHER TECHNOLOGY: ONE (reserved for S.T. candidates)

B. ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF :

- i) CIVIL ENGINEERING : TWO (1 reserved for S.C. candidates)
- ii) MECHANICAL ENGINEERING : THREE (2 reserved for B.C. candidates)
- iii) ELECTRONICS & COMMUNICATION ENGINEERING : FOUR (2 reserved for S.C. candidates)
- iv) COMPUTER SCIENCE & ENGINEERING : TWENTY THREE (5 reserved for S.C., 2 each for S.T., and B.C. candidates and 1 for Persons with disabilities)

PAY: For the post of Professor –Rs.16,400/- - Rs. 22,400/-(unrevised); Assistant Professor – Rs. 12,000/- - Rs. 18,300 (unrevised).

N.B.: The posts of Professor and Assistant Professor are transferable from one State Government Engineering/Technological College to another within the State of West Bengal.

AGE: Not more than 50 years for the post of Professor and 40 years for the posts of Assistant Professor on 01.01.2009, upper age limit is relaxable in the case of candidates who are specially qualified and experienced and also in case of candidates who are already employed in Institutions/Organisations under the State Government or Central Government.

QUALIFICATION FOR THE POST OF PROFESSOR : Essential : i) Doctorate degree with a first class degree at Bachelor's or Master's Level in the appropriate branch of Engineering/Technology; ii) 10 (ten) years' experience in Teaching/Research/Industry out of which 5 years' must be at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent.

NOTE : Candidates from Industry/Profession with Master's degree in Engineering/Technology and with professional work which is significant and with 10 years' experience of which at least 5 years' should be at a Senior Level, would also be eligible.

QUALIFICATION FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR: Essential: i) Doctorate degree with a first class degree at Bachelor's or Master's level in the appropriate branch of Engineering/Technology; ii) 3 (three) years' experience in Teaching/Research/Industry in the appropriate field at the level of Lecturer or equivalent.

NOTE : Candidates from Industry/Profession with Master's degree in Engineering/Technology and with professional work which is significant and with 5 years' experience at a Senior Level, would also be eligible.

2. **PRINCIPAL-SUPERINTENDENT, J.B. ROY STATE AYURVEDIC MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL, KOLKATA, UNDER H. & F.W. DEPTT., GOVT. OF W.B. – 1 (unreserved).**

PAY: Rs. 10,000 – 15,525/- (unrevised).

QUALIFICATIONS : **Essential :** (i) Degree in Ayurveda from a recognised University established by Law or Statutory Board/Faculty/Examining Body of Indian Medicine or its equivalent as recognised under Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970; (ii) Post graduate degree in Ayurveda; (iii) Ten years' teaching experience out of which there shall be five years' teaching experience as Reader/Assistant Professor or ten years' experience as Lecturer, wherever the post of Reader/Assistant Professor does not exist; (iv) Adequate knowledge in Sanskrit.

DESIRABLE: (i) Research experience with original published paper/Books. (ii) three years' administrative experience.

AGE: Not more than 45 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable for the candidates having higher qualifications and/or experience than those prescribed in these rules and for the candidates having substantive appointment under the Govt.

N.B.: (i) Private practice not allowed. (ii) Selected candidates shall, prior to joining, produce a certificate of registration with Paschim Banga Ayurveda Parishad.

3. **DAIRY MANAGER (RESEARCH) & DAIRY MANAGER IN W.B. HIGHER DAIRY DEVELOPMENT SERVICE: TWO (1 reserved for S.T. candidates).**

PAY: Rs. 10,000 – 15,525/- (unrevised).

QUALIFICATIONS : **Essential :** (i) Second class degree or diploma in Dairy Science/Dairy Engineering/Dairy Technology/Food Engineering/Food Technology/Animal Husbandry/Veterinary Science or Second Class degree in Agriculture or degree in Engineering; (ii) Post-Graduate degree or diploma in any branch of Dairy Science; (iii) Five years' experience of Management in any branch of large milk supply scheme or dairy undertaking; (iv) Familiarity with recent advances in dairy industry; (v) Administrative experience in a responsible position.

DESIRABLE: (i) Research experience or specialised training in any branch of Dairy Science.

N.B.: Qualifications are relaxable at the Commission's discretion for well-qualified and experienced candidates.

AGE: Not more than 40 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable in the case of highly qualified and experienced candidates and for persons already in the service of a Govt. or a statutory body or a recognised institution.

4. **DEPUTY MILK COMMISSIONER (COMMERCIAL & ENFORCEMENT) IN WESET BENGAL HIGHER DAIRY DEVELOPMENT SERVICE (GENERAL): ONE (reserved for S.C. candidates).**

PAY: Rs. 10,000 – 15,525/- (unrevised).

QUALIFICATIONS : **Essential :** (i) Second class Honours or Master's degree in Arts/Science/Commerce; (ii) Eight years' experience in a responsible capacity in dealing with the organisation of sales, purchase of stores in any Government Organisation or a Statutory Body or a Commercial concern of repute; (iii) Knowledge of Bengali – Spoken and Written.

DESIRABLE : (i) Advanced training in milk marketing administration; (ii) Degree in Law.

NOTE : Qualifications are relaxable at Commission's discretion for otherwise well qualified and experienced candidates.

AGE : Not more than 40 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable for highly qualified and experienced candidates and for persons already in service of a Government or Statutory Body or a recognised Institution.

5. **ECONOMIST-CUM-CREDIT PLANNER UNDER THE DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING DEPARTMENT, GOVT. OF WEST BENGAL : EIGHTEEN (5 reserved for S.C. and 1 each reserved for S.T. & B.C. candidates and Persons with disabilities).**

PAY: Rs. 10,000 – 15,525/- (unrevised).

QUALIFICATIONS : **Essential :** (i) Second class Master's degree in Economics with statistics as one of the subjects. (ii) Five years' experience in the preparation and assessment of plans and projects. **or** Five years ' teaching experience in Economics in a degree college or above.

NOTE : The period of experience is relaxable at Commission's discretion for otherwise well-qualified candidates.

AGE : Not more than 40 years on 01.01.2009.

6. **ASSISTANT ENGINEER (MECHANICAL) IN THE W.B. SERVICE OF ENGINEERS (MECHANICAL) : FIVE** (1 each reserved for S.C. & S.T. candidates).

PAY: Rs. 8,000 – 13,500/- (unrevised).

QUALIFICATIONS: Essential: Degree in Mechanical Engg. or equivalent qualifications.

DESIRABLE: One years Post-Graduate practical training or study or research or practical Engg. experience.

AGE : Not more than 32 years on 01.01.2009, age limit in the case of candidates who are already in the employ of the Central and State govt. or in Statutory body recognised for the purpose by the Govt. or who had been in such employment but are not out of such employment for more than a years on 01.01.2009, shall be relaxable to the extent of actual period spent continuously in such employment.

NOTE: i) Candidates will be selected on the basis of a competitive examination followed by interview; ii) Eligible candidates would be called in for the written examination. Thereafter candidates qualifying in the written examination would be called to interview; iii) The syllabus for the written examination will generally be in conformity with the educational standard/technical qualifications as prescribed in the essential qualification. Details of the syllabus and date, time and venue of the written examination will be intimated to eligible candidates in due course; iv) The Commission reserves the right for fixing qualifying marks both for the written examination and the interview and also in aggregate in respect of General, S.C., S.T. and B.C. candidates; v) No candidate will be allowed to take more than three chances.

7. **DEVELOPMENT OFFICER IN THE WEST BENGAL GENERAL SERVICE UNDER THE DEPTT. OF MICRO & SMALL SCALE ENTERPRISES & TEXTILES, W.B. : FOUR** (1 reserved for S.T. candidates).

PAY: Rs. 6,000 – 12,000/- (unrevised).

QUALIFICATIONS: Essential: A degree/diploma in Textile Technology/Handloom Technology from a recognised University/Instt. Diploma in Handloom Technology shall be given preference.

DESIRABLE: (i) Knowledge of Law regulating Co-operative Societies and the rules made thereunder; (ii) Knowledge of Inspection and testing of Textile Materials.

AGE : Not more than 35 years on 01.01.2009, relaxable at the discretion of the P.S.C., W.B. for candidates having higher qualification and/or longer experience than those prescribed and for persons holding substantive appointment under the Government.

8. **SUB-DIVISIONAL INFORMATION AND CULTURAL OFFICER IN WEST BENGAL GENERAL SERVICE UNDER THE DEPTT. OF INFORMATION AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS, GOVT. OF W.B. : SIX** (1 each reserved for S.C. and B.C. candidates).

PAY: Rs.5,500 – 11,325/- (unrevised).

QUALIFICATIONS: Essential: (i) A degree of a recognised university; (ii) Degree or diploma in Journalism / Masscommunication/Public Relations; (iii) Thorough acquaintance with the rural life of West Bengal (With the life of the people of Darjeeling – in the case of Hillmen); (iv) Ability to address gathering in Bengali (Nepali or any other Gorkhali language in the case of Hillmen).

AGE : Not more than 32 years on 01.01.2009.

FEES: Candidates must enclose with their application a fee of Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred) only for the posts at item (1) to (6) and Rs. 150/- (Rupees one hundred fifty) only for the posts at item (7) & (8) by Indian Postal Order which **MUST BE PURCHASED ON A DATE AFTER PUBLICATION OF THIS ADVERTISEMENT** and crossed and endorsed to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, West Bengal, or by a receipted Challan from a Govt. Treasury in West Bengal or the Reserve Bank of India, Kolkata under the head "0051-00-105-State PSC Examination fees-001-Examination fees-16 other fees". The Postal Orders should be made payable at G.P.O., Kolkata. Money Order, Cheque, Bank Draft, Cash etc. will not be accepted. No application will be considered unless accompanied with the requisite application fees. Candidates belonging to S.C./S.T. of West Bengal and persons with disabilities specified under Persons With Disabilities Rules, 1999 are not required to pay any fee. The application of such candidates will not be accepted if the same is not accompanied with the attested copy of S.C./S.T./Persons with Disabilities certificate. Such exemption of fees is, however, not applicable to any B.C. candidate. No claim for refund of the fee will be entertained nor will it be held in reserve for any other examination.

INFORMATION

1. Candidates who wish to apply for more than one category of posts should submit separate application alongwith requisite fees for each.
2. The qualifications prescribed in the advertisement are as per the notified recruitment rules issued by Government.
3. All the degrees/diplomas/certificates mentioned in the advertisement must have been obtained from recognised Universities/Institutions.
4. The prescribed 'essential qualifications' are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle applicants to be called in for the interview. Where the number of applications received in response to the advertisement is large and it is not convenient or possible for the Commission to interview all the applicants the Commission may restrict the number of candidates for interview to a reasonable limit on the basis of either qualifications or experience higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement or on the basis of a Screening Test /Written Test .
5. In cases where no Division/Class is awarded and only grading is done, exact percentage of marks and conversion formula adopted are to be mentioned with documentary evidence.
6. Where experience of a number of years is prescribed as an item of qualification this would mean only experience/research experience gained in full time employment/research.
[Certificate(s) from the Head(s) of Organisation(s)/Department(s) for the entire experience claimed, clearly mentioning the duration of employment (date, month and year) and indicating basic pay and consolidated pay must be furnished together with applications. The certificate(s) should also mention the nature of duties performed/experience obtained in the post(s) with duration(s)].
7. Besides pay, the posts carry allowances as admissible.
8. The benefits of reservation of vacancies and upper age concession upto 5 years are admissible only to S.C. and S.T. candidates of West Bengal and upto 3 years to B.C.candidates of West Bengal. S.C., S.T. and B.C. candidates of other States may apply for unreserved vacancies as general candidates. Such benefits are also available upto 45 years for Persons with Disabilities.
