QUALIFICATIONS: (i) Medical qualifications included in the first or second Schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, and Registration as Medical Practitioner in West Bengal, (ii) 1 (one) year's practical training as House Staff in any Govt. hospital; or other recognized Institutions, (iii) recognized Post-graduate qualifications in respective speciality or equivalent qualification.
