MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES RECRUITMENT EXAMINATION, 2011

Applications in the prescribed format are invited from Indian citizens or such other nationals as are declared eligible by the Govt. of India for various posts under different departments, Govt. of West Bengal, recruitment to which are made, in accordance with the rules, through **Miscellaneous Services Recruitment Examination**.

The examination will be held by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal in three successive stages viz. (1) Preliminary Examination (Objective Type), (2) Final Examination (Conventional Type – Written) and (3) Personality Test, as detailed below.

The Preliminary Examination will be held at various centres in West Bengal in **September, 2011** or thereabout. Only **Scheduled Tribe** candidates of Darjeeling district and other candidates of its three hill subdivisions, viz. Darjeeling Sadar, Kalimpong and Kurseong may appear at Darjeeling centre.

The Final Examination will be held in **January, 2012** or thereabout in **Kolkata** only and the Personality Test in the Commission's office at Kolkata.

CANDIDATES SUFFERING FROM BLINDNESS OR LOW VISION AND REQUIRING HELP OF A SCRIBE WILL BE REQUIRED TO APPEAR AT KOLKATA (SOUTH) CENTRE ONLY.

PAY : (PB-3) Rs.7,100-37,600/- + Grade Pay of Rs.3,900/- [for **12** different categories of posts]
Gross emoluments at the entry level : **Rs.12,270/-** besides D.A., M.A. & H.R.A. admissible as per rules.
(PB-3) Rs.7,100-37,600/- + Grade Pay of Rs.3,600/- [for **7** different categories of posts]
Gross emoluments at the entry level : **Rs.11,040/-** besides D.A., M.A. & H.R.A. admissible as per rules.

All appointments will initially be made on a temporary basis. Number of vacancies will be announced later.

QUALIFICATIONS :

- i) A citizen of India or such a person of other nationality declared eligible by Government of India.
- ii) A degree of a recognized University or its equivalent.
- iii) Ability to read, write and speak in Bengali (not required for recruitment in the case of Nepali speaking candidates from hill areas of the District of Darjeeling).

AGE :

On 1st January, 2011 – not below 20 years but not more than 32 years (i.e. born not earlier than 2nd January, 1979 and not later than 1st January, 1991). Upper age limit is relaxable by five years for SC/ST and three years for BC candidates of West Bengal and upto 45 years of age for persons with disabilities (PWD) having physical disability of 40% and above.

FEE :

Candidates must enclose with their applications a fee of Rs.160/- (Rupees One Hundred and Sixty) only in the form of Indian Postal Order or in the form of receipted challan from a Government Treasury in West Bengal or the Reserve Bank of India, Kolkata. Candidates belonging to SC/ST of West Bengal and Persons with Disabilities specified under Persons with Disabilities Rules, 1999 are not required to pay any fee. Such exemption of fees, is however, not applicable to any BC candidate.
